

ORDER ON IA

The legal representatives of petitioner have filed this application U/Order XXII Rule 3 of CPC seeking permission to come on record as the legal representatives of the deceased petitioner in this case.

2. In the affidavit annexed to the application it is stated that, the above petition is filed against the respondents for claim of compensation for the accidental injuries happened on 03.10.2023 and during the pendency of the petition the husband i.e., the petitioner died on 23.03.2025 leaving behind herself and her son and daughter as the legal heirs. If this application is not allowed they will be put much hardship and irreparable damages will be caused to them, and prayed to allow this application.

3. On the other hand, respondents not filed objection to this IA, hence objection to IA taken as not filed.

4. Heard, perused materials on record.

5. The legal representatives of the petitioner have filed this application to come on record to claim the compensation for the accidental injuries caused on 03.10.2023 against the respondents. During

the pendency of this petition, it came to be informed by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has died on 23.03.2025 and death certificate of the original petitioner by name Govindaraju K is also been filed.

6. The death certificate filed by the counsel for the petitioner which specifies that the petitioner by name Govindaraju K has died on 23.03.2025. Thereafter, this application came to be filed within time. Therefore, right to sue survives on the legal representatives of the petitioner. Hence, I feel it is just and proper to allow the application in the ends of justice. So, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

IA filed U/Order XXII Rule 3 of CPC is hereby allowed.

The legal representatives of the petitioner are permitted to come on record as petitioner No.1(a) to 1(c).

petitioner counsel to carry out the amendment and furnish the amended petition by: 23.10.2025.
