3. I am the owner of Toyota Innova Car Bearing No KA-01-AB-0927. At the time of accident I was driving the said car. I was trying to take a u-turn and was waiting for the same at that time accident occurred. It is false to suggest that as I suddenly turned the vehicle from the left edge of the road towards right side without following traffic rules and without observing the movement of vehicles.

4. The insurance policy pertaining to my vehicle got expired on the date of accident. I had valid DL at the time of accident. It is false to suggest that since my vehicle did not have valid insurance at the time of accident, I am personally liable to pay compensation to the petitioner. It is true to suggest that the IO has filed the chargesheet against me and I have pleaded guilty and paid the fine in the criminal case.

5. It is false to suggest that since the accident occurred due to my negligence and since my vehicle was not insured at the time of accident, I am personally liable to pay compensation to the petitioner.
