

ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT-01 IN CRI.M.A.NO.262/2020.
(CNR NO.MHPA04-000664-2020)

Present bail application is filed under section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

2- The learned advocate for applicant submitted that the allegations made against the applicant that she abetted the deceased to commit suicide. Actually, this applicant never abetted to commit suicide. She had quarrel with deceased and in said quarrel, she threatened to commit any kind of offence against him. At the most offence under Sec. 506 of IPC is made out against the applicant. She had never intention that deceased should commit suicide. The another accused was already released on bail. The applicant is ready to follow all the condition imposed by this court. Hence, the applicant may be released on bail.

3- Learned APP submitted that the nature of applicant is aggressive. When the deceased was alive at that time, she went to the house of deceased and took out quarrel with him. In the life time of deceased she did not bother about deceased. If the applicant is released on bail, she would put pressure on the family members of the deceased. It would cause hurdle in the investigation. Hence, the application may be dismissed.

4- On perusal of record, it finds that, in the FIR, the informant alleged that applicant was having illicit relations with one Shivaji Shinde. When husband of informant came to know about this, he told

her not to do such thing. In that situation, the applicant went to the house of deceased and threatened that she would do anything with the help of Shivaji. Therefore, the deceased committed suicide. Almost all the witnesses are relatives of the informant. She was in jail since 2.9.2020. Almost all the investigation is completed by the police. The presence of this applicant is not required with the police for further investigation. It is correct that there are chances that she may put pressure on the witnesses, in that situation, the condition can be put on the applicant that she could not visit to the village Rupur, Tq. Kalamnuri for certain period. Hence, following order is passed.

Order.

- 1- The application is allowed.
- 2- The applicant be released on bail on her furnishing P.R. bond of Rs.30,000/- (Rs. Thirty thousand only) with one or more sureties in the like amount.
- 3- The applicant shall provide her phone number and phone numbers of her sureties to the I.O so that Investigating Officer should establish contact with them.
- 4- The applicant is directed to remain present at police station as and when directed by the I.O. during 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. for the period of three months or till filing of charge-sheet whichever is earlier on every Thursday.
- 5- The applicant shall not put pressure directly or indirectly on witnesses.
- 6- The applicant shall remain away from village Rupur, Tq. Kalamnuri, Dist. Hingoli for the period of three months or till filing the charge-sheet, which ever earliest.

7- Bail before J.M.F.C.

8- Inform learned J.M.F.C. and
concerned police station accordingly.
