Plaintiff and defendant are present. Their counsel also present.

Plaintiff and defendant have filed compromise petition U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC stating that they have compromised the matter as per the advice of conciliators and elders of the family according to the terms of compromise petition.

Perused the contents of compromise petition, pleadings of the parties and documents produced in the suit.

The terms of the compromise are in accordance with law. Further, the parties have admitted the contents of the compromise application. It appears that the compromise is voluntary. Hence, it is just and proper to record the

compromise, since it is a legal one.

In the result, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The suit is decreed in terms of compromise petition filed by the plaintiff and defendant U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC.

Draw the compromise decree accordingly.

The compromise petition filed by the parties is part and parcel of the compromise decree.

Office is directed to return the Court Fee to the plaintiff.

Accordingly, the matter is disposed-off.
