3. Do the plaintiffs prove that the partition deed dt:22.07.2019 is null and void and not binding on them as alleged in para no.1 of the plaint?
4. Do the plaintiffs prove that the sale deed dt:25.02.2021 and 25.01.2021 are null and void and not binding on them as alleged in para no.1 of the plaint?
5. Is the defendant no.23 is bonfide purchaser for the value?
6. Is the suit bad for partial partition?
7. Is the suit is barred by time?
8. To what shares the defendants are entitled?
9. To what relief the parties are entitled?
10. What order or decree?
