

The petitioner has filed the application I.A No.I U/O 26 Rule 9 of CPC seeking for the appointment of the Taluk Surveyor as court commissioner to demarcate suit properties. In support of the said application, the applicant has also filed Affidavit and for the reasons stated in the Affidavit she prayed to allow the applications.

The respondents have not opposed the applications by filing objections.

Admittedly, the judgment and decree passed in O.S.No.23/2018 reached finality and for the demarcation of the suit schedule properties as per the decree it is necessary for the appointment of the court commissioner. Hence, I find sufficient grounds to allow the application.

The suit schedule properties are the agricultural lands hence the Taluk Surveyor attached to the officer of ADLR/Thasildhar,

H.D Kote is appointed as commissioner to demarcate the said property as per preliminary decree.

The commissioner fees are tentatively fixed at Rs.2000/-.

Issue commission warrant to the aforesaid commissioner if fee is deposited and P.F. is paid.
