File has been taken up today on the bail application of the accused Jagdish Prakash Singh.

Present:- Sh. S.K. Tripathi, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.
Ms. Nehmat Sethi, Ld. Counsel for the accused.
IO/SI Vishvendra Malik in person.

Reply of the application has been filed.

Counsel for accused has submitted that no other bail application of the accused is pending either before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi or before any other court; that the accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case; that the accused is in custody since 22.11.2025; that the accused and the victim are Ex-servicemen and were employed as Security Guards and were living together in a room; that a scuffle had taken place between them on a minor issue, which was blown out of proportion; that the fight had taken place without any premeditation; that no weapon was used during the commission of the offence; that accused has clean antecedents; that accused has to look after his family comprising four members; that investigation is complete and charge-sheet has also been filed; that no fruitful purpose will be served by keeping the accused in custody and thus, he may be admitted to bail.

Per contra, Ld. Addl. PP for the State opposed the application submitting that the injured was badly beaten up by the accused and was rescued by the neighbourers; that when the injured was rescued, he was unconscious and was badly bleeding

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from mouth and nose; that the injured was beaten up in such a manner that till date, he is not able to speak and is under treatment; that currently, the injured is taking help of ventilator for breathing; that though the accused is recuperating at home, he is bedridden and is not able to speak.

I have heard the arguments and have gone through the record.

During the course of arguments, IO submitted that the statement of the injured has not been recorded till date because he is not able to speak. Moreover, the supplementary charge-sheet has been filed alongwith the report of Army Hospital, mentioning that the victim is currently unable to talk and unable to understand the commands. Moreover, he has been referred to neurosurgeon for further treatment.

Considering the fact that statement of the injured has not been recorded till date, due to his medical condition; during the incident, the injured suffered injury on vital parts of his body including the head, which is life threatening in nature and that, the injured has suffered serious injury and is still not able to speak, this court is not inclined to admit the accused Jagdish Prakash Singh to bail. Accordingly, the application stands dismissed.
