

ORDER

Plaintiff filed I.A No. I U/o 32 rule 1 and 3 CPC praying to appoint defendant no.5 as natural guardian for their minor children i.e., defendant no.6 & 7.

Admittedly defendant no. 6 & 7 are minors and they are unfit to prosecute the case independently. In the result defendant no.5 is appointed as guardian for defendant no. 6 & 7 to prosecute the case on her behalf.
