The above named accused have been sent up before this Court by the Station House Officer, Police Station Badli to face trial under Sections 126, 309(4), 311, 351(3), 61 read with Section 3(5) of BNS.

2. Final report under Section 193 of BNSS has been filed. Copies of it complete in all respect have been supplied to the accused free of cost as envisaged under Section 207 Cr. PC/230 BNSS.

3. Brief facts of the prosecution case are the present FIR was registered on the basis of written complaint submitted by the complainant Vikas@Vicky, which was addressed to SHO police Station Badli, wherein it is pleaded that he has been working as a driver for the last 13–14 years. For the past six months, he has been employed as a driver with SAM Traders Company, Nangloi, Delhi. On 11.03.2026, he along with his conductor Sonu left Nangloi at about 2:30 PM in vehicle Tata ACE bearing No. DL1LAH7493 to deliver goods such as detergent and soap. At about 4:30 PM, they unloaded goods at Ravi Store, Main Market, Jhajjar. After the delivery, his conductor Sonu collected ₹2,21,600/- from the store and handed the amount over to him. He kept the money behind the driver's seat in the vehicle. Thereafter, at about 5:00 PM, they reached Sai Ram Store, Jhajjar, where they unloaded more goods. His conductor collected another ₹1,50,000 from the store and handed it over to him. He kept this amount in the same bag. He was driving the vehicle and Sonu was sitting on the passenger seat. At about 6:30 PM, while they were traveling on the Jhajjar–Bahadurgarh Road, a short distance from Jagannath University towards Dulheda, a red-coloured motorcycle carrying three young men came their vehicle. Two of them were wearing helmets, while the third had covered his face with a white cloth. They signalled him to stop the vehicle. Suddenly, the motorcycle rider stopped the motorcycle in front of his vehicle, forcing him to stop. As soon as, he stopped, all three persons approached the vehicle. One of them opened the driver's side door and pointed a pistol at him. Another person went to the conductor's side, slapped his conductor Sonu and all three accused robbed ₹3,71,600/- at gunpoint. They then fled from the spot on the motorcycle. While leaving, they threatened both

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of them with dire consequences, saying that if they informed anyone about the incident, they would kill them. Thereafter, he informed his employer, Mohan Singla, about the entire incident. He prayed that legal action might be taken against the culprits.

On the basis of said complaint and the circumstances found at the spot, a case under Section 126, 309(4), 311, 351(3), 61 read with Section 3(5) of BNS. After completion of investigation, challan was presented before the Court.

4. Since, the offence punishable under Sections **311 of BNS** is exclusively triable by the Learned Court of Sessions, therefore, the present case is committed to the learned Sessions Court, Jhajjar, for **29.07.2026**. Accused are directed to be produced before the Learned Sessions Judge, Jhajjar on **29.07.2026** at 10:00 a.m. sharp. Subject to the provisions of BNSS relating to bail, accused are remanded to judicial custody during and till the conclusion of trial. Ahlmad of this Court is directed to send the case file, complete in all respects, to the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Jhajjar, well in advance. Since, the present order has been pronounced in the presence of learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, therefore, he stands notified about the same and no separate notification is required to be issued to the State. List of witnesses be prepared accordingly. Reader is also directed to prepare the Calandra in this case. File be sent to the Court concerned.
