

### **Order on I.A.No.I**

The application I.A.No.I is filed by the applicant U/O 32 Rule 3 of CPC to appoint the guardian for minor plaintiff.

2. It is stated in the affidavit accompanying to the application that the plaintiff is the minor children of applicant and the applicant may be appointed as minor guardian since she is the mother of minor plaintiff.

3. Heard the arguments of counsels for plaintiff.

4. The present application has filed by the applicant to permit her to act as guardian of minor plaintiff. The affidavit accompanying to the application reveals that the plaintiff who is the minor is the son of applicant and the applicant is the mother of said minor plaintiff. It is sworn that there is no any adverse interest between the plaintiff. Since the applicant is the mother of minor plaintiff, there would not be any adverse interest and it is necessary to appoint her as guardian to protect the interest of minor plaintiff. Hence this court proceed to pass the following:

### **ORDER**

**The application I.A.No.I filed by the applicant U/O 32 Rule 3 CPC is hereby allowed.**

**The applicant is hereby permitted to prosecute the present case as minor guardian of plaintiff.**
