1. Do the plaintiffs prove that the suit schedule properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of the plaintiff and defendant no.1 to 6?
2. Are the plaintiffs entitled for partition and separate possession to the extent of 1/2 share in the suit schedule properties?
3. Do the plaintiffs prove that the registered gift deed dated 16.12.2008 is null and void and not binding on them as alleged in Para No.3 of the plaint?
4. Do the plaintiffs prove that the registered sale deed dated 21.09.2012 is null and void and not binding on them as alleged in Para No.4 of the plaint?
5. Does the defendant No.7 prove that he is the bonafide purchaser for valid consideration of the item no.9 of the suit properties?
6. To what shares the defendant's no.1 to 6 are entitled?
7. To what relief the parties are entitled?
8. What order or decree?
