

Order on I. A No. III

The counsel for appellant has filled the application U/O 5 rule 20(1) R/W section 151 of CPC praying for an order to permit the appellant to take steps against respondent no.2, 4(a), 4(b) and 5 by way of affixture under substituted service.

2. The application is supported by affidavit of the appellant and it is shown that he has already taken steps against respondent no.2, 4(a), 4(b) and 5 through ordinary summons and RPAD but the said respondents are deliberately and purposefully evading the service of summons. Hence prayed to allow the application.

3. Heard counsel for appellant.

4. On perusal of the order sheet it appears that the summons were issued to respondent no.2, 4(a), 4(b) and 5 through ordinary summons and registered post but they were returned as unserved. Now appellant has filed the present application for substituted mode of service through affixture. By considering the reasons, the application deserve to be allowed. Hence this court proceed to pass the following;
