The plaintiff and
defendants and their counsel
present. Counsel for the
plaintiff filed the carried out
amendment and filed the
amended plaint taken on
record.

The counsel for
defendants Sri.S.H., files
vakalath for defendant No.1 to
15 along with two application
U/o 9 Rule 7 of CPC praying to
recall the exparte order passed
by this court. The counsel for
plaintiff submits no objection
to allow the application.

Heard allowed.

Further counsel for
defendants filed another
application U/o 32 rule 7 of
CPC praying to settled the
matter on behalf of the minior
defendant No.4, 5, 8, 9 and 13
by their natural guardian
defendant No.3, 7 and 12. The

counsel for the plaintiff submits they have no objection to allow the application.

Heard and perused the application satisfied and parties have settled their dispute and settled the matter and above settlement is not in the against the interest of the minor defendants. Hence, application is allowed in the interest of justice. Further counsel for defendant also filed certificate stating that above said compromise is in the interest of the minor defendants. Hence prays to order the same. Further counsel for plaintiff also filed genealogical tree of the defendants family along with the Aadhar card. memo is accepted.

Both the parties and their counsel files compromise petition U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC. The contents of said compromise petition have been

read over to both parties and they have admitted the same as true and correct.

Perused the contents of compromise petition, pleadings of the parties and documents produced in the suit. The terms of the compromise are in accordance with law. It appears that compromise is voluntary. Hence, it is just and proper to record the compromise, since it is a legal one.

In the result, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The suit is decreed in terms of compromise petition filed by the plaintiff and defendants U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC.

Draw the compromise decree accordingly.

The compromise petition filed by the parties is part

and parcel of the
compromise decree.

Office is directed to return
the Court Fee to the
plaintiff and also the
documents produced after
obtaining copies of the
same. If any application is
filed by the parties.
Accordingly, the matter is
disposed-off.
