

ORDERS ON I.A.No. I

Perused the I.A.No. I filed U/O.39 Rule 1 and 2 of C.P.C., the plaintiff averments and the documents filed along with the suit.

The plaintiff instituted suit for permanent injunction against the defendants. The plaintiff claim to be the absolute owner and in possession of suit schedule property. He has filed documents in support of his case. The plaintiff has shown apprehension that the defendants are trying to interfere in his possession over the suit property.

There are no grounds to disbelieve the assertion of the plaintiff stated on oath by swearing an affidavit at this stage. The plaintiff has made out prima-facie case at this stage in his favour. Hence, the exparte temporary injunction as prayed in I.A.No.I has to be granted till next date of hearing. Accordingly, I pass the following:-

ORDER

The exparte temporary injunction as prayed in I.A.No. I is granted.

The defendants are restrained from interfering in the possession of the

plaintiff over the suit schedule property till the next date of hearing.

Issue ex parte temporary injunction order as prayed in I.A.No. 1 after compliance of Order 39 Rule 3 of C.P.C.

Issue summons to the defendants and notice of I.A.No.1.
