Hence, substance of accusation made for the offence P/U/S 7(3) of Lottery Regulation Act and same is read over and explained to the accused. He pleaded guilty of the said offence. Hence, accused is convicted for the offence P/U/S 7(3) of Lottery Regulation Act and sentenced to pay fine of **Rs. 3,000/-**. In default to pay the same they shall under go simple imprisonment for 07 days.

I.O is directed to produce the property.

The amount of Rs. 2,800/- seized under P.F. No. 41/2026 is forfeited to state and property No. 1 i.e., lottery tickets seized under P.F. No. 41/2026 are being worthless ordered to be destroyed after appeal period.
