

Orders on I.A.No.I

Sri.CMC, counsel for Plaintiff has filed this suit against the defendants for the relief of permanent injunction in respect of suit schedule property along with I.A.No.I seeking for ex-parte ad-interim order of temporary injunction against the defendants restraining the defendants, their family members or anybody acting on their behalf from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of plaintiff over the suit schedule property till disposal of the suit.

It is stated in the accompanying affidavit of IA that, suit schedule property is the absolute and self acquired property of plaintiff. The plaintiff has obtained loan of Rs.1,50,000/- on the suit property from Agricultural Co-operative Society, Hommaragalli Branch by mortgaging the suit property. The defendants have no manner of right, title or interest over the suit property, but they trespassed into the suit property on 03.01.2024 at 10.00 a.m., and caused obstruction to the agricultural activities of plaintiff. The plaintiff resisted the interference of defendants, but they have not stop the illegal interference. Hence, the present suit is filed along with this application.

Heard, learned counsel for the plaintiff. Perused the plaint averments, I.A. & Affidavit and supported documents.

On perusal of the records, the defendants' presence is necessary before granting the ex-parte temporary injunction.

Hence issue emergent notice on IA.No.I and suit summons to the defendant, if PF paid.
