

IA No.1 is filed by the plaintiff under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC seeking an ex parte ad interim Order of temporary injunction to restrain the defendants from alienating the suit properties.

IA No.2 is filed under Order 32 Rule 2 and 3 read with section 151 of CPC seeking to appoint the defendant No.2 as the guardian for defendants No.3 and 4 to represent them in this suit as she is their mother.

The plaintiff has filed this suit seeking a relief of declaration that she is owner in possession of the suit schedule property and for canceling the registered Sale Deed executed by defendants No.1 to 5 in favour of defendant No.6 on 27.03.2015 and also for the consequential relief of permanent injunction. Perused the supporting affidavit filed by the plaintiff and documents produced by him. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of relief sought in the suit and the nature of relief sought in the IA and the Registered Sale Deed dated 27.03.2015, at this juncture, it appears that it is necessary to hear the defendants before passing any order on IA No.1. Hence, the following:
