Orders on I.A.No.1

Sri.KSS, counsel for Plaintiff has filed this suit against the defendants for the relief of permanent injunction in respect of suit schedule property along with I.A.No.1 seeking for ex-parte ad-interim order of temporary injunction against the defendants restraining the defendants, their family members, their followers, agents or anybody acting on their behalf from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of plaintiff over the suit schedule property till disposal of the suit.

It is stated in the accompanying affidavit of IA that, plaintiff is the absolute owner and in possession of suit schedule property acquired through consent deed from her father. The plaintiff has constructed a shed measuring 70 x 30 feet in the suit property and obtained Demand register from the Village panchayath. The defendants have no manner of right, title or interest over the suit property, but they are interfering with the peaceful possession of plaintiff over the suit property. During the year 2021 the plaintiff sanctioned a house from the government, when she was making arrangements for the construction of house, at that time defendants illegally trespassed and obstructed the construction

of house. The plaintiff resisted the act of defendants through panchayathdars, but the defendants did not stopped their illegal interference. Hence, the present suit is filed along with this application.

Heard, learned counsel for the plaintiff. Perused the plaint averments, I.A. & Affidavit and supported documents.

On perusal of the records, the defendants' presence is necessary before granting the ex-parte temporary injunction.

Hence issue emergent notice on IA.No.1 and suit summons to the defendants, if PF paid.
