

Accused present.

The counsel for accused filed bail application U/sec.478 of BNSS.

**ORDERS ON BAIL APPLICATION
FILED UNDER SEC.478 OF B.N.S.S**

The counsel for accused has filed this bail application U/sec.478 of BNSS seeking to enlarge the accused on bail.

It is contended in the bail application that, accused is innocent and law abiding citizen and he has not committed any offence alleged by the complainant police. Under the instigation of some enimical persons towards the accused, complainant police foisted false case against the accused person. He has got movable and immovable property in his village. He is the only earning member in his family and his detention will cause great hardship and inconvenience to his family members. The accused is ready to furnish surety to the satisfaction of this Court. Further undertakes to appear before the Court on all the dates of hearing without fail and undertakes to abide by the conditions imposed by this Court. Also undertakes not to tamper with the prosecution witness. Hence, prays to enlarge him on bail.

On the other hand, the learned APP has orally objected to the bail application.

Heard and perused the materials on record.

The offences alleged against the accused are punishable U/sec.281, 125(a) of BNS Act. Though the said offences are non-bailable in nature, but they are not punishable with imprisonment for life or death, and the

same are triable by this Court. Moreover, the Investigation of the case is already completed and charge sheet is filed against the accused. Further the accused has undertaken to abide by the conditions that may be imposed by this Court and further undertaken to furnish surety to the satisfaction of this Court.

On considering the gravity of the offence and the ground urged in the application, the bail application filed by the accused U/sec.478 of BNSS is hereby **allowed** and the accused is enlarged on bail, on the following:-

CONDITIONS

1. The accused is directed to execute personal bond for a sum of Rs.50,000/- with a surety for likesum;
2. He shall attend before the Court on all dates of hearing without fail;
3. He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence;
4. He shall produce certified copy of identity card for proof of his address.
