

Case called before the LOK-ADALATH

Complainant, accused and their respective counsel are present. The complainant and accused have filed joint compromise petition under section 147 of NI Act read with section 431 of Cr.P.C read with 471 of BNSS stating that, they have settled the matter for Rs.2,00,000/- and the accused has paid Rs.1,00,000/- to the complainant and submitted no objection to release the amount in deposit of Rs.42,000/- to the complainant. Accused has agreed to pay the remaining agreed/settled amount in terms of the joint compromise petition and prays to close the case in terms of joint compromise petition. The terms of the compromise petition is read over and explained to both the parties and they admitted the same. Since parties have settled the matter in terms of compromise petition, there is no impediment under law to record the compromise. Hence, the compromise petition filed by complainant and accused under section 147 of NI Act read with section 431 of Cr.P.C read with 471 of BNSS is taken on record.

Hence, this case is closed as settled in terms of joint compromise petition before the Lok Adalath.

Any violation of terms of compromise, the complainant is at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.

Office is hereby directed to release the amount in deposit of Rs.42,000/- to the complainant on proper identification.
