

Plaintiff No. 1 to 3 and defendant No. 1 and 2 present. Advocate for plaintiffs files compromise petition U/ S 23 Rule 3 of CPC on 09.02.2026 along with copies of Aadhar cards of parties. They have prayed to pass final decree in terms of compromise petition . All the plaintiffs have compromise the suit for 16 lakhs each and they received 5 lakhs each through cash on 09.02.2026.

Today Plaintiffs counsel files memo and stating that the plaintiffs No. 1 to 3 are received the remaining balance amount of Rs. 11 lakhs each through cheques as mentioned in compromise petition.

On being question of the parties with respect to the terms of compromise petition, the plaintiffs and defendants have admitted the terms and affixed their signatures before court by accepting the contents of compromise petition. Both the plaintiffs have received cash and defendant No. 1 and 2 are ready to allot joint plaint schedule properties as mentioned in the compromise

petition. They have duly signed before the court by accepting contents therein in the compromise petition as well as in the order sheet. The compromise is in accordance with law.

In view of compromise petition filed by the parties, I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

By invoking order 23 Rule 3 of CPC, the compromise petition filed by the parties is hereby allowed.

Consequently, the suit of plaintiff is hereby decreed in terms of compromise petition.

Draw final decree accordingly. The terms of compromise petition part and parcel of the decree.
