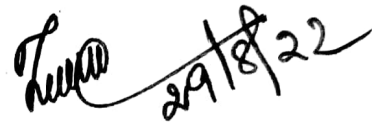

ISSUES

1. Whether plaintiff proves that suit schedule properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of plaintiff and defendant No.1 and 2?
2. Whether defendants prove that for the purpose of marriage expenses of plaintiff, father of plaintiff and defendants No.1 and 2-Marikalegowda, his wife and children sold 1 acre of land in suit Sy. No.5/2 under registered sale deed dated:24-2-1995?
3. Whether defendants further prove that plaintiff already got her share in suit Sy.No.5/2 measuring 0.20 guntas during the life time of her father and she herself sold the said property in favour of defendant No.3?
4. Whether defendant No.5 and 6 prove that they are the bonafide purchasers of suit schedule properties item No.10 and 11 under registered sale deed dated 07-7-2010 for valuable consideration?
5. Whether suit of the plaintiff is bad for non joinder of necessary parties as contended by defendant No.5 and 6?

6. Whether suit of the plaintiff is barred by law of limitation?
7. Whether plaintiff is entitle for the relief of partition and separate possession in all the suit schedule property as sought for?
8. What order or decree?
