

After hearing the learned counsel for the plaintiff and also referring to the pleadings and documents produced by her, it appears that plaintiff has filed the present suit for partition and separate possession of her 1/6th share in the suit schedule properties. Along with the plaint, plaintiff has filed IA No. I U/O 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC for exparte temporary Injunction against the defendant No.1 and 2. At this stage, on perusal of pleading and records, this court finds prima-facie materials to pass an exparte temporary

injunction against the defendant No.1 and 2 till next date otherwise if the same is not granted, the purpose of filing of the suit would be defeated. To preserve the subject matter intact, I deem fit to pass the following:

O R D E R

The defendant No.1 and 2 or anybody acting on their behalf are hereby restrained by way of an order of ex parte temporary injunction from alienating the suit schedule properties in favour of anybody in any manner till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff is directed to comply Order 39 Rule 3(a) & (b) of CPC then only office to issue the said order. Issue suit summons all defendants along with and notice on IA-1 to defendant No.1 and 2 returnable by 01-03-2023.
