1. Whether plaintiffs prove that the suit schedule properties are the ancestral and Hindu undivided joint family properties of plaintiffs and defendant No.1?
2. Whether plaintiffs prove that defendant No.1 alienated the portion of suit schedule properties to defendant No.2 on 17.01.2024 illegally and without any absolute right?
3. Whether the plaintiffs further prove that the alleged sale deed dt:17.01.2024 is not binding on the share of plaintiffs?
4. Whether the defendant No.1 proves the effecting of separate khata of suit schedule property as per the oral partition said to be took place between the plaintiff No.1 and 2 and father of defendant No.1 on 24.03.1997?
5. Whether suit is barred by law of limitations?
6. Whether plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession of their 1/3rd share in the suit schedule properties by metes and bounds as prayed for?

7. What order or decree?
