1. Whether the plaintiff proves that the suit schedule property is the ancestral joint family property of plaintiff and defendant No. 1 and 2 available for partition?
2. Whether the plaintiff further proves that himself and defendants No.1 and 2 are in joint possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property as on the date of the suit ?
3. Whether the plaintiff further proves that he is entitled for 1/3rd share in the suit schedule property by metes and bounds ?
4. Whether the plaintiff further proves that there is already a registered partition dated 10.01.2020 and as per the said partition suit schedule property was allotted to one Smt. Ningajamma @ Thayamma the mother of the plaintiff and defendants No. 1 and 2?

5. Whether the defendant No.1 and 2 prove that their mother Smt. Ningajamma @ Thayamma before her death, orally partitioned the suit schedule property and accordingly the defendant No. 1 and 2 are the owners of the suit schedule property?
6. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession as prayed for?
7. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the mesne profit as prayed for?
8. What order or degree?
