4. Whether the defendant No.1 proves a registered Will dated 14.03.1996 executed by Sri. Late Basappa in his favour in respect of the property allotted to the share of late Basappa ?
5. Whether the plaintiff further proves that he is entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession as prayed for ?

6. Whether the plaintiff further proves that he is entitled for the declaration of the sale deed dated 29.12.2015 registered in the office of the Sub-Registrar, Hunsur registered as document No.10349/2015-16 is not on the plaintiff ?
7. What Order or decree?
