I S S U E S

- 1) Whether the plaintiff proves that the the defendants No. 1 to 3 colluding with defendants No. 4 and 5 trying to create false documents with the aid of revenue and Grama panchayath officials and defendants No. 1 to 3, 4 and 5 are trying to alienate the suit schedule properties?
- 2) Whether the defendants prove that the defendants No. 5 and 6 are not joint family members of Late.Ningappa and are purchased the item Nos. 13 and 14 of the suit schedule property for valuable consideration under registered sale deed jointly executed by defendants No. 1 to 3?
- 3) Whether the defendants prove that the schedule property bearing item No. 1 of the suit schedule property is granted under sagavalli in the name of the 2nd defendant is his self acquired property and item No. 9, 11 and 12 of the suit schedule properties was bequeathed under Will deed dated 05.08.1998 by Ningappa father of the plaintiff and defendants No. 1 to 2 in favour of his grand children Madhu?

- 4) Whether the defendants prove that the suit is bad for partial partition in the suit schedule property?
- 5) Whether the defendant No. 3 proves that the plaintiff has already take her share at the time of marriage through gold and cash and defendant has already taken share in the plaint schedule property on 27.03.1993 through panchayath palu patti and registered partition deed dated 24.09.2016?
- 6) Whether the defendant No. 3 prove that the suit of the plaintiff is bad for non joinder of necessary party and properties?
- 7) Whether the plaintiff proves that she is entitle for 1/4th share in the suit schedule properties?
- 8) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the reliefs claimed?
- 9) What Order or Decree?
