ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT-1

1. Today the claimants are present with their Advocate Shri. R. K. Dhage. The respondent No.3 Go Digit General Insurance Co. Ltd. appeared through its Counsel Shri. D. S. Kulkarni. The Advocate himself is authorized to put signature on behalf of the respondent No.3 insurance company vide the Authority Letter (Exh.21).
2. Both the parties admit the terms and conditions as stated in the compromise (Exh. 22). They have filed joint compromise pursis at Exh. 20. The insurance company is agreed to pay Rs.16,50,000/- towards full and final settlement to the claimants, within 45 days from the date of the award.
3. On deposit of the agreed amount, the claimant No. 1 is entitled to for an amount Rs.7,00,000/-, out of which Rs.2,00,000/- be kept in F.D. for two years in any nationalized bank in the name of claimant No.1, claimant No. 2 & 3 are entitled for an amount of Rs. 4,00,000/-each, out of which Rs.2,00,000/- each be kept in F.D. for two years in any nationalized bank in the name of claimant No.2 & 3, the claimant No. 4 & 5 will be entitled for an amount of Rs. 75,000/- each.
4. In case the respondent No.3 failed to deposit the amount of Rs.16,50,000/- within 45 days, the said amount will carry the

future interest @ 6 % per annum.

5. As such the present MACP stands disposed of in terms of compromise. Award be drawn up accordingly.
