

Case called before lok Adalat.

Plaintiffs and defendant present. Sri. NN for plaintiffs and Sri.NDS for Defendants present. Parties agreed to compromise the case. Both the parties and counsels filed joint compromise petition U/Sec. 20 of Karnataka Legal Services Authorities Act. The terms of compromise read over to them before Lok Adalat and admitted by the parties. The compromise entered between the parties is voluntary, without force, coercion, undue influence and misrepresentation. The identification of the parties is verified by their Adhar cards. Memo with self attested copies of Ahdar Cards of the parties furnished. In terms of compromise plaintiffs paid Rs.5 lakh to the defendant through cheque bearing No.086207 drawn on Union Bank of India. Hence, proceeds to pass the following;

ORDER

The joint compromise petition filed U/Sec. 20 of Karnataka Legal Services Authorities Act is hereby accepted.

The case is disposed before Lok

Adalath in terms of the compromise entered between the parties. Draw decree in terms of compromise. The compromise petition shall be part and parcel of the decree. Refund court fee to the plaintiffs as per rules.
