

Case is taken on board.

Plaintiff is present. Plaintiff counsel files compromise Petition U/O 23 Rule 3 of CPC reporting settlement between the bank and defendants. The defendants have compromised for Rs. 6,50,000/- out of that Rs. 2,00,000/- deposited before Bank today. Defendants have to pay remaining balance amount of Rs. 4,50,000/- before 14.05.2026. If failing which the plaintiff Bank as liberty to recovery full claim amount.

On being question of the parties with respect to the terms of compromise petition, the plaintiff Bank and defendant has admitted the terms and affixed their signatures before court by accepting the contents of compromise petition.

The compromise Petition is signed by the manager of the plaintiff bank. In the compromise Petition it is stated that the defendant has settled the claim with the plaintiff bank.

ORDER

By invoking The compromise petition U/O 23 Rule 3 of CPC is filed by the plaintiff Bank and its counsel is hereby accepted.

Consequently, the suit of plaintiff is hereby decreed in terms of compromise petition.

Draw final decree accordingly. The terms of compromise petition part and parcel of the decree.

In view of compromised petition office is hereby permitted refund court in favour of plaintiff in accordance with law. Hence pass the following order.

The compromise petition filed by the plaintiff bank and their counsels is hereby accepted. In view of the settlement between the parties, the suit is hereby disposed before Lok Adalath.
