I S S U E S

1. Whether plaintiff proves that the suit schedule properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of plaintiff and defendant No.1 to 6?
2. Whether plaintiff proves that the registered sale deed bearing No.2325/2001-02 is not binding on the plaintiff's right of share in the suit schedule properties?
3. Whether defendant No.7 proves that the suit schedule item No.1 property bearing Sy.No.48/1 was sold by defendant No.1 and 4 in favour of father of defendant No.7 for a valuable consideration amount of Rs.40,000/- to meet their legal necessities?
4. Whether defendant No.7 proves that suit is bad for non inclusion of other properties of the family as contended in para No.7 of his written statement?
5. Whether suit of the plaintiff is barred by time?
6. Whether plaintiff is entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession of 1/6th share in the suit schedule properties by metes and bounds?

7. What order or decree?
