4. Whether the defendants prove that the defendant No.2 alienated the suit schedule item No.2 in favour of the defendant No.3 through the Sale Deed dated:6.7.2011 and intern the defendant No.3 has alienated the suit schedule item No.2 by retraining 12 guntas in favour of defendant No.4 through the sale deed dated:30.7.2012?
5. Whether the plaintiff is entitle to relief sought?
6. What Order or Decree ?
