

Case called out before National Lok-Adalath.

Counsel for plaintiff and defendant present. Parties are present filed joint memo. In view of the conciliation held by the conciliators.

The present suit is filed by the plaintiff against the defendant for the relief of recovery of money. On enquiry the plaintiff and defendant have agreed to the terms of the compromise petition.

As per the compromise petition the DHR has agreed to receive amount of Rs.2,32,360/- from the defendant. As per the said compromise the defendant has to pay Rs.1,16,000/- within three months from this date i.e., on 10.06.2026 and the second instalment of Rs. 1,16,360/- shall be paid to the plaintiff on or before 10.09.2026. Further the defendant has agreed that if he fails to pay the amount the plaintiff shall have the right to recover the full amount with interest at 23% per annum from the defendant by filing an execution petition to the Court.

The contents of joint compromise petition are read over and explained to the parties. The parties admits the contents and execution of joint compromise petition as true and correct. The joint compromise petition submitted by both the parties appears to be voluntarily made. Further both the counsels have put their signature in the order sheet. Joint Compromise petition is accepted. Hence, I proceed to pass the following :

:: ORDER ::

The Joint compromise petition filed by the plaintiff and defendant is hereby accepted. Suit of the plaintiff is hereby decreed in terms of the compromise petition filed.

Draw decree as per compromise petition.

Compromise petition is part and parcel of the decree.

Office is hereby directed to return the court fee as per law.
