ORDERS

The present petition is filed by the Petitioner U/Sec.13(3) of The Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969.

2. The Petitioner has prayed for issuance of direction to the respondent to register the death event of Siddaiah S/o Late. Kalaiah, who died on

25.07.1985 at Gavadagere Village, Gavadagere Hobli, Hunsur Taluk, Mysuru District.

3. In spite of service of notice, the Respondent remained absent before the Court and as such his objection was considered as nil. The matter was posted for enquiry of the Petitioner.

4. In order to substantiate her case, the Petitioner got herself examined as P.W.1 and got marked five documents at Ex.P.1 to Ex.P.5. Thereafter, the Petitioner closed evidence on her side.

5. Heard the arguments advanced by the learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused materials on record.

6. The points that arise for the consideration of the court are:

P O I N T S

1. Point No.1: Whether Petitioner made out grounds under section 13(3) of Birth and Death registration Act to seek for direction to the Respondent for entering the date of death of Siddaiah S/o Late. Kalaiah in the concerned register ?

2. What order?

7. On consideration of the materials placed on record, this court answers the aforesaid points as hereunder:

Point No.1: In the *Affirmative*

REASONS

8. **Point No.1:** As aforesaid the Petitioner got herself examined as P.W.1 and reiterated the petition averments in her examination-in-chief. She has further deposed that, Siddaiah S/o Late. Kalaiah is no more. P.W.1 has specifically deposed that, her father died on 25.07.1985 at Gavadagere Village, Gavadagere Hobli, Hunsur Taluk, Mysuru District. Further she has deposed that, death certificate is required for Government benefits.

9. The Petitioner in support of her case has relied upon Ex.P.1 which is the Notarized copy of the Genealogical tree, Ex.P.2 is the non-availability certificate issued by the office of the respondent, Ex.P.3 is the Notarized copy of Aadhar Card, Ex.P.4 and Ex.P.5 are the Paper Publications.

10. As stated supra, the Respondent has remained absent before the court. The evidence of P.W.1 has thus remained unchallenged and unrebutted. Ex.P.2 which is non-availability certificate clearly goes to show that, the death event of Siddaiah S/o Late. Kalaiah is unregistered. Ex.P.4 and Ex.P.5 goes to show that, the date of death of Siddaiah S/o Late. Kalaiah is not disputed by any other person. Now after applying for the death certificate with Respondent, the Respondent has pleaded his inability to furnish the death extract on the ground that the death of Siddaiah S/o Late. Kalaiah was not entered in the concerned register. Therefore, if the relief sought by the Petitioner is declined, she will be put to hardship. Apart from this, there is nothing on record to disbelieve the evidence lead by the Petitioner. Under these circumstances, this Court has no other alternative than to accept the evidence of P.W.1. Accordingly, this Court answers **Point No.1 in the Affirmative.**

11. **Point No.2:** In the light of foregoing discussions, this court proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER

The petition filed U/s 13(3) of The Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 is hereby *allowed*.

The respondent is hereby directed to make proper entry in respect of date of death of Siddaiah S/o Late. Kalaiah as 25.07.1985 at Gavadagere Village, Gavadagere Hobli, Hunsur Taluk, Mysuru District.

The Respondent shall collect the prescribed fee from the Petitioner.

No order as to cost.
