Notice u/s 251 Cr.P.C. framed against the accused. Notice has been readover and explained to the accused to which he pleaded not guilty and claimed trial. Plea of defence of accused has been recorded.

Statement u/s 294 Cr.P.C. of the accused is recorded. The witness mentioned at Srl. Nos. 2, 3 & 4 are dropped from the list of witness.

An oral request has been made by the Ld. Counsel for the accused for allowing examination u/s 145(2) NI Act. Same has not been opposed by Ld. Counsel for the complainant.

Considering the above submission of the Ld. Counsel for the complainant and the plea of defence taken by the accused in his statement u/s 251 Cr.P.C, an opportunity to cross examine the

complainant is fit to be given to the accused u/s 145(2) NI Act. The present case shall be tried as a summons case.

At this stage, parties state that they are willing to settle the present case. Accordingly, the matter is referred to mediation centre. Both the parties are directed to appear in person before the Mediation Centre, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi today itself at 12:30 PM.

Put up the matter for report of settlement, if any / furnishing of bail bonds and cross examination of CW-1 on 16.10.2026.
