

Case called out before National Lok-Adalath.

Counsel for plaintiff and defendant present. Parties are present filed joint memo. In view of the conciliation held by the conciliators.

The present suit is filed by the plaintiff against the defendant for the relief of recovery of money. On enquiry the plaintiff and defendant have agreed to the terms of the compromise petition.

As per the joint compromise petition the plaintiff agreed to receive Rs. 35,000/- from the defendant and today the defendant has paid Rs. 5,000/- to the plaintiff. The remaining amount of Rs. 30,000/- will be paid to the plaintiff on 20.06.2026. If the defendants fail to pay the plaintiff within the stipulated period, plaintiff is at liberty to file suit to recover an amount of Rs. 1,15,000/-.

The contents of compromise petition are read over and explained to the parties. The parties admits the contents and execution of compromise petition as true and correct. The compromise petition submitted by both the parties appears to be voluntarily made. Further both the counsels have put their signature in the order sheet. Compromise petition is accepted. Hence, I proceed to pass the following :

:: ORDER ::

The compromise petition filed by the plaintiff and defendant is hereby accepted. Suit of the plaintiff is hereby decreed in terms of the compromise petition filed.
