ORDER

This petition is filed by the petitioner U/s.13(3) of the Birth and Death Registration Act, praying to direct the respondent to make an entry of the date of birth of petitioner as 5/6/1981 in the Birth Register maintained by the respondent.

2. The petitioner in her petition has contended as follows:

That she is a permanent resident of No.378/1, 6th Main Road, Coffee Day, Nagendra Block, Bengaluru South, Bengaluru. By oversight, inadvertence and bonafide mistake, the date of birth of petitioner by name Komala M.N. D/o Nanjundaiah and Smt.Jayamma as on 5/6/1981 No.378/1, 6th Main Road, Coffee Day, Nagendra Block, Bengaluru South, Bengaluru was not brought to the notice of the respondent. As such there is no entry in the concerned Birth Register maintained by the

respondent. The petitioner knew this fact when she went to take the Birth Certificate. Hence, prayed to allow the petition.

3. After service of notice respondent has not appeared and placed ex-parte.

4. The petitioner examined herself as P.W.1 and got marked 3 documents at Ex.P1 to Ex.P3 and closed her side. On the other hand the respondent did not lead any evidence.

5. The points that arised for my consideration of this Court are:

1. Whether the petitioner has made out grounds to register date of birth of petitioner as 5/6/1981 in the register maintained by respndent?

2. What order?

6. My findings on the above points are as follows:

Point No.1: In the Affirmative

::REASONS::

7. **Point No.1:** The petitioner in order to prove her case examined herself as P.W.1 and got marked 3 documents at Ex.P1 to Ex.P3. P.W.1 in her evidence has stated that she has born on 5/6/1981 at No.378/1, 6th Main Road, Coffee Day, Nagendra Block, Bengaluru South, Bengaluru.. It is pleaded that when she has approached Birth Registrar for the purpose of getting Birth Certificate, but respondent has not registered date of birth in concerned Register. It is further contended that she has not informed the date of birth of petitioner due to unawareness of the law. Ex.P.1 is the Non-Availability Certificate issued by the respondent wherein it is mentioned that date of birth of petitioner is not recorded in concerned Register. She has also produced notarised copies of PAN Card, Transfer Certificate of petiitoner, which are marked at Ex.P2 and Ex.P3.

8. On perusal of the affidavit and the documents produced by the petitioner, it appears from the records that the petitioner has no mala fide intention. Hence, it is just and necessary to direct the respondent to enter the date of birth of petitioner by name Komala M.N. D/o Nanjundaiah and Smt. Jayamma as on 5/6/1981 in the Birth Register maintained by the respondent. Hence, this Court answered the above Point No.1 in the Affirmative.

9. Point No.2: In view of the above reasons given on Point No.1, this Court proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioner U/s. 13(3) of Birth and Death Registration Act is allowed with no order as to costs.

The respondent is directed to enter the date of birth of petitioner by name Komala M.N. D/o Nanjundaiah and Smt. Jayamma as on 5/6/1981 in the Birth Register and to issue the Birth Certificate

to the petitioner as per law by taking late fee.
