**The evidence of witness i.e., CW-35 is recorded through Video conference, In the presence of Public prosecutor, Accused, Advocate for accused.**

Since 2013 till now I am working as Assistant Professor in Department of Forensic Medicine, Mysore medical college, Mysore. On 27/04/2016, I received requisition from PSI of HD Kote Police Station, crime no 89/2016, U/S 143,147,306 R/w 149 IPC to conduct postmortem of deceased Dasa shetty and conducted postmortem on same day between 11:45 am and 12:45am.

ON EXTERNAL EXAMINATION:

Clothes and Articles:

1. Blue colour Lungi

2. Black colour Lungi with white dotted design and white rose floral design.
3. Dark grey trouser.
4. Waist thread.
5. Wrist thread.
6. Silver colour ring.

After examination, the above mentioned articles and clothes were handed over to the concerned police in a sealed manner along with sample seal. Silver colour ring handed over to the concerned police in unsealed manner

Dead body is that of a male aged 66 years measuring 167 cm in length, moderately built and nourished. Post mortem staining present over the back of the body and head. Rigor mortis present all over the body. Eyes intact.

Following external injuries noted:

1. Abrasion 3 x 2 cm present over the front of the chest at its left side upper one third aspect.
2. Contusion measuring 7 x 4 cm present over the left side of front of the chest at its middle one third.
3. Abrasion 2 x 0.5cm present over the back of the right elbow.
4. Abrasion 2 x 1cm present over the front of the left knee.

On dissection of body;

**Scalp** on reflection shows extravasation of blood over the both parietal area.

**Skull** shows obliquely placed sutural fracture at the right side of coronal suture measuring 8cm. Fissure fracture measuring 7cm

present over the left parietal bone one end attached to the sutural fracture.

**Membranes** intact.

**Brain** severe edema present, c/s unremarkable.

**Spinal cord** intact not opened.

**Chest walls, ribs and sternum** intact, no fracture. **Pleura and cavity** intact, no free fluid. **Larynx and Trachea:** intact.

**Lungs:** both lungs are purplish, heavy and firm, on c/s exudes frothy hemorrhagic fluid s/o consolidation

**Pericardium, heart and large vessel** external intact, coronaries patent, valves intact, aorta intact.

**Abdominal wall** intact. **Peritoneum** intact, no free fluid. **Mouth, pharynx and esophagus** intact.

**Stomach** 50cc of yellow colour fluid, smell peculiar mucosa congested, **Small and large intestines** contain gas and its contents.

**Liver and spleen** intact and congested, c/s unremarkable.

**Kidneys** intact and congested, c/s unremarkable. **Bladder** intact and empty. **Organs of generation, external and internal** intact c/s unremarkable.

- All the above mentioned injuries are antemortem in nature.
- Abrasions covered with brownish black scab
- Contusion is brown in colour.
- Blood effused around fracture site.
- Blood and viscera collected, preserved, labelled, sealed and handed over to the concerned police to RFSL for chemical analysis.
- Opinion reserved pending for the want of chemical analysis report and hospital case sheet.

**Provisional opinion** was given as opinion reserved pending for want of hospital case sheet.

**Death is due to cardio respiratory failure due to consumption of Organo phosphorus insecticides.**

Further Opinion: Since the deceased has been treated for 4 days, so poison that consumed by deceased is metabolized in body and excreted so detection of poison by FSL has become negative. Opinion is given on hospital treatment basis.

Further Opinion to letter dated 25/03/17

1. Injuries mentioned in PM report page-02 are not sufficient to cause death in ordinary course of nature.
2. Spinal cord – intact. Not opened. No injury sustained to spinal cord.
3. 3 – 4 days.
4. Yes, possible upto 3 – 4 days from beginning of treatment.
5. Infection of lungs leading to respiratory failure and death 3/5/17.
