Present: Mr. Prateek Mehta along with Mr. Dhruv Chhabra counsel for plaintiff through VC.

Mr. Adil Muneer Andrabi counsel for defendant through VC.

1. On the request of counsel for plaintiff, plaintiff is granted two weeks more time for filing of replication as well affidavit of admission/denial *qua* defendant's documents. Advance copy of same be supplied to counsel for defendant.

2. Pleadings in the suit are complete. Matter is ripe for settlement of issues.

3. On the basis of pleadings of the parties, the following issues are framed:-

(i) *Whether plaintiff is entitled for recovery of an amount of Rs.5,58,803/- as prayed for? OPP.*

(ii) *Whether plaintiff is entitled for pendente lite and future interest, if so, at what rate?OPP.*

(iii) *Relief.*

No other issue arises or pressed for.

4. Both the parties are directed to file list of witnesses within 15 days from today. Affidavit of evidence of plaintiff's witnesses be filed within four weeks with advance copy to counsel for defendant.

5. Defendant is also directed to file his affidavit of evidence as well as of his witnesses, if any within four weeks with advance copy to counsel for plaintiff.

6. Parties are ready and willing to settle the dispute amicably through the process of mediation. Accordingly, as prayed, the present matter is hereby referred to **Delhi Mediation Centre, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi** for exploring possibility of an amicable settlement of dispute. Parties are directed to appear before learned Judge Incharge, Mediation Centre, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi on **04.04.2026 at 2:00 PM**

7. Re-notify for settlement, if any otherwise for plaintiff's evidence on **02.05.2026**.
