I S S U E S

- 1) Whether the Plaintiffs proves that, Plaintiffs and Defendants constituted Hindu joint family members and the suit schedule properties are their ancestral and joint family properties?
- 2) Whether the Plaintiff proves that, suit schedule Item No.1 is their ancestral property and suit schedule Item No.2 to 5 are acquired out of the income generated from suit schedule Item No.1 and from hard labour of the joint family members?
- 3) Whether the Plaintiffs proves that, suit schedule Item No.2 and 3 are purchased on 19.11.1993 and on 29.04.1995 respectively out of the joint family income?
- 4) Whether the Defendant No.2 proves that, suit is bad for partial partition as properties of Sri.Sannathamma @ Kalegowda S.S. not included in the suit?
- 5) Whether the Defendant No.2 proves that, suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary and proper parties to the suit?

- 6) Whether the Defendant No.2 proves that, Defendant No.1 acquired the suit schedule Item No.1 through the Registered Settlement Deed dated 15.06.1949 executed by the grand father of Plaintiff No.1 by name Ningegowda?
- 7) Whether the Defendant No.2 proves that, Defendants are entitled for share in the counter claim properties?
- 8) Whether the Defendant No.2 proves that, counter claim properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of the Plaintiff and Defendants?
- 9) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for relief of partition as prayed?
- 10) What order or decree?
