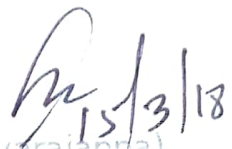

I S S U E S

1. Whether plaintiff proves that, the suit schedule properties are the ancestral joint family properties of plaintiff and defendants and they are in their joint possession?
2. Whether the defendant No.1 to 9, 10 to 18 prove that, already partition had been taken place in the joint family of the plaintiff and defendants vide Panchayath Palu Parikath dated 22-06-1990 in respect of the plaint and written statement schedule properties and the said Panchyath Palu Parikath has been acted upon by plaintiff as well as family members of the defendants?
3. Whether the defendants further prove that, plaintiff has not included all the joint family properties in the plaint schedule and hence the suit is not maintainable for partial partition?
4. Whether the plaintiff is entitle for the reliefs as sought for?
5. What order or decree?
