I S S U E S

- 1) Whether the Plaintiffs proves that, Plaintiffs and Defendants No.1 to 4 constituted Hindu joint family and the suit schedule properties are their ancestral and joint family properties?
- 2) Whether the Plaintiffs proves Sale transactions and Gift transactions made by Defendants No.1 and 4 in favour of Defendants No.5 to 13 not binding on their shares?
- 3) Whether the Defendant No.5 proves that, suit in respect of Item No.8 is not maintainable as Defendants No.1 to 3 sold this property prior to commencement of Hindu Succession Act, 2005 in his favour?
- 4) Whether the Defendant No.5 proves that, he was a bonafide purchaser without notice?
- 5) Whether the Plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession as prayed?
- 6) Whether the Plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of Mense profits as prayed?
- 7) What order or decree?
