

CS-467-2026 Gurtej Singh Vs. Jarnail Singh & ors.

Present: Sh. Sanjeev Kumar Garg Advocate counsel for plaintiff.

Suit received by entrustment. Report of Reader seen. It be registered. Alongwith the suit, an application under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 CPC for grant of interim relief has also been filed by the plaintiff.

The ld. Counsel for the plaintiff argued for granting of exparte interim injunction that restraining the defendants not to stop the plaintiff from using the motor connection to the extent of his share as detailed mentioned in the head note of the plaint. In order to substantiate his claim Ld. Counsel for plaintiff has relied upon various document i.e. jamabandi for the year 2022-2023, copy of khasra girdawari, copy of pass books and copy of the pedigree table. In the light of the referred documents and submission made by the counsel, the Court is of the opinion that the prima facie case is made out in favour of the plaintiff, balance of convenience also lies in his favour, irreparable loss will be caused to the plaintiff if exparte injunction is not granted to the plaintiff and the very purpose of the provision will be defeated. Hence, the plaintiff is entitled to the relief of exparte interim injunction and defendants are restrained not to stop the plaintiff from using the motor connection to the extent of his share as detailed mentioned in the head note of the plaint till **29.05.2026**.

Compliance of Order 39 Rule 3 CPC be made within 24 working hours, failing which this order will automatically stands vacated. Notice of the application as well as suit be issued to defendants for **29.05.2026** through ordinary process as well as registered post on filing PF etc. Dasti summons also be taken.
