

ORDER BELOW EXH. 04 IN CRI.BAIL APPLICATION No.1171/2022

. The main application is filed for grant of anticipatory bail as per section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code (hereinafter referred to as the "Cr.P.C."), as the applicant is apprehending arrest at the hands of police station Taluka Jalna in crime No.650/2022 for an offences punishable under sections 143, 147, 148, 307, 336, 120-B, 427 and 506 r/w section 149 of the Indian Penal Code (hereinafter referred to as the "I.P.C.") and under section 25, 3 and 4 of the Arms Act, 1959.

02. For the main application, notice has been issued to the prosecution and say of the A.P.P. and the Investigating Officer has been called for.

03. This application Exh.4 is preferred for grant of interim protection from the arrest. It is submitted that the applicant is the practicing lawyer in the District Court at Jalna. Along with the main application, as per list Exh.3, several documents have been placed on record inclusive of registered sale-deed, which is document no.3 from pages no.07 to 26, showing that the applicant has purchased land from one Sandhya Daga. The learned advocate Shri.S.C.Arora for the applicant has taken me through the contents of the sale-deed as well as the contents of the F.I.R. On affidavit, it is submitted that on the date and time of the incident, the applicant/advocate has appeared in the Court. It is submitted that the role assigned to this applicant

as per the F.I.R. appears only with regard for hatching the criminal conspiracy and no active role has been alleged.

04. Considering overall facts and circumstances as well as the documents placed on record, interim protection of not to arrest is granted to the applicant/accused till 12.10.2022. Prosecution to file the say on the main application. The matter be kept for say and hearing on 12.10.2022. Investigating Officer to remain present along with case-diary.
