**ORDER IA NO.1 FILED U/O 39 R-1 AND 2 of CPC**

IA No.1 is filed by the applicant/plaintiff U/o 39 R-1 and 2 seeking an ad-interim ex-parte order of temporary injunction restraining defendant/Opponent, his supporters from interfering with the Plaintiffs peaceful possession and enjoyment of plaint schedule property/application schedule property and dealt with the same pending disposal of present suit in the interest of justice and equity.

**2.** Heard the learned counsel for the applicant/plaintiff. Perused the plaint averments, affidavit, annexed to IA No.1 and also other materials placed before this court.

**3.** The above suit is filed by plaintiff against defendant for the relief of Permanent Injunction.

**4.** Further as per the endorsement made in order sheet there is no caveat pending respect of suit schedule property.

5. on perusal of the documents and hearing the arguments of the counsel for the plaintiff on the IA No.1, till the defendant made their appearance before this court, it is just and necessary to direct the defendant from causing any interference with the suit schedule properties. If the relief of injunction ex-parte is not given, the very purpose of filing the suit will be defeated. Hence this court proceed to pass the following.

### **ORDER**

The Defendant is hereby restrained from interfering with the suit schedule property by way of an ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order.

This order shall remain in force till defendant filing his written statement and objections.

Office is directed not to issue the certified copy of this order until complied with order 39 R-3 of CPC.
