

ORDER ON APPLICATION FILED U/S 125(3) OF CR.P.C

The petitioner No.1 along with the petitioner No.2 have filed the present application U/s 125(3) of Cr.P.C. against respondent for interim maintenance of Rs. 6,000/- to each of the petitioners.

2. The brief fact of the case are as under:

The petitioner No.1 submits that, her marriage with respondent held on 27-03-2014 at the Beerappaswamy Temple in the Lakshmipura Village, Saligrama Taluk as per the Hindu rituals in the presence of parents, relatives and elders of the community. During the marriage the parents of the petitioner No.1 offered jewelry and other valuable things including cash in favour of the respondent and performed marriage. After her marriage with respondent she lead cordial matrimonial life with respondent for few years and during the wedlock petitioner No.2 was born. Later, respondent started to harass to petitioner and he has demanded petitioner to bring further dowry from parents. She being unable to tolerate the harassment caused by the respondent with regard to further dowry she has left him.

3. She further submits that respondent is having sufficient source of income and she is unable to maintain herself and also the petitioner No.2 for their food, cloth and other expenses. As such she has filed the present application seeking interim maintenance of Rs.6,000/- per month to the petitioner No.1 and 2 each.

4. Heard and perused.

5. At this stage on careful perusal of the application averments, in the absence of exact source of income of the respondent, this court finds it just and proper to award reasonable interim maintenance to the petitioners as they are the wife and son of respondent till further orders by this court with that regard. Hence, this court proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER

Pending disposal of application filed U/s 125(3) of Cr.P.C respondent is directed to pay total amount of Rs.2,000/- per month in favour of the petitioner No.1 and 2 until further orders by this court.
