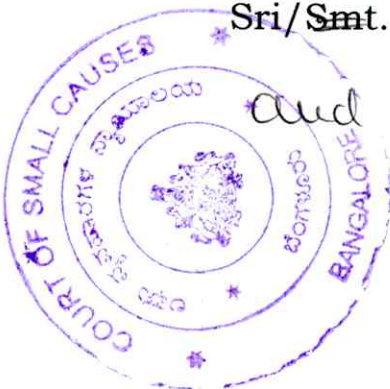

ORDER

The claim petition filed by the petitioner is hereby allowed in part with costs.

The petitioner is entitled to a total compensation of Rs.6,69,895/- + cost of Rs.1,000/- imposed vide order on IA No.II and III. The petitioner is entitled for sum of **Rs.6,70,895/- (Rupees Six Lakhs Seventy Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety Five only).**

After deducting cost of Rs.1000/- and future medical expenses to the tune of Rs.20,000/- balance sum of Rs.6,49,895/- shall carry interest at 6% per annum from the date of petition till the date of deposit.

The respondent No.1 & 2 are jointly and severally liable to pay the above compensation amount to the petitioner. However, the primary liability to pay the compensation amount is fastened on respondent No.2- Insurance Company and



it is directed to pay the said amount within two months from the date of this order.

On deposit of the said amount and interest, 50% of compensation payable to the petitioner shall be deposited in his name in any nationalized bank of the choice of petitioner for a period of 3 years and remaining 50% shall be released to the petitioner through E-payment on proper identification.

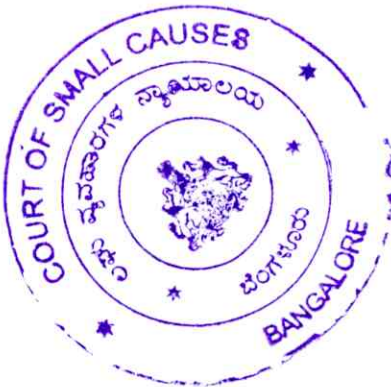
Advocates' fee is fixed at Rs.1,000/-.
