The case is pending since last many dates for awaiting report qua accused Gaurav Matta/Raj Rani from Director General of Police but no such report has been placed on record. On 02.09.2025, it was submitted by her counsel before this court that inquiry against accused Gaurav Matta (not arrested till date) was pending before the Director General of Police. It was further submitted that in case, he is found innocent, the very purpose of framing charge under Section 27 (A) of the NDPS Act against accused Raj Rani shall be a futile exercise. As three material witnesses had already been examined, this court adjourned the case for awaiting the report as the re-examination of the said three witnesses may be avoided, in case accused Raj Rani is found innocent in the pending inquiry against accused Gaurav Matta/Raj Rani. However, at this stage, when no such report has come since about four months, there is no justification to keep adjourning the case for the said purpose. The only recourse which may be adopted is that the witnesses already examined may not be summoned in the meanwhile and the trial be proceeded as such.

Consequent upon the filing of supplementary challan against accused Raj Rani and Gaurav Matta, it is appropriate that all the challans are

tried together. Accordingly fresh charge is required to be framed against accused Amardeep, Manish Kumar and Raj Rani also.

Arguments heard on the point of framing of charge. From the perusal of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. and the documents attached therewith, a prima facie case under Sections 22(c), 27-A & 29/61/85 of Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 is made out for framing of charges.

Amended Charge has been framed against accused Amardeep for offence under Section 21 (c) /61/85 of Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, against accused Manish Kumar for offence under Section 29/61/85 of Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and against accused Raj Rani for offence under Section 27-A of Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. The charges were explained to the accused individually to which they pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

The case is adjourned to 13.04.2026 for prosecution evidence. PWs mentioned at Sr. No. 1 & 5 to 9 in the list of the witnesses be summoned for the date fixed.
