

Order below petition, Exh.01 in
M.A.C.P.No.1400/2024, dated 22.03.2025

01. See Terms of settlement, Exh.16 and order below it, dated 20.03.2025.

02. Claim between the petitioners and insurance company is fully and finally settled at **Rs.07,00,000/- (Rs. Seven Lakh Only)**, including NFL. Consequently, opponent – owner is exonerated from liability. Considering intention of the parties, following order is passed :-

ORDER

01. Petition, Exh.01 is disposed of as compromised between the parties, in National Lok-adalat, dated 22.03.2025.
02. Opponent- Insurance Company shall deposit settlement amount of **Rs.07,00,000/- (Rs. Seven Lakh only)**, including amount of N.F.L., within period of one month from the date of award, in bank account of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Thane, by RTGS or NEFT, as per directions of the Hon'ble Apex Court in Writ Petition No. 534/2020.
03. If it fails to comply Clause 02 above, settlement amount shall carry interest @ 8% p.a. from the date of award till its actual realization.
04. On realization of settlement amount, it be apportioned as under :-
 - a. Amount of **Rs.04,00,000/- (Rs. Four Lakh only)**, be paid to petitioner no.01, namely Mrs. Jaspal Kaur M. Mattu, by RTGS or NEFT.

b. Amount of Rs.01,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh only), each, be paid to petitioner nos.02, 03, and 04, namely Miss Parmit Kaur Mattu, Miss Amrit Kaur Mattu, and Virender Singh Mattu, respectively, by RTGS or NEFT.

05. The petitioners shall furnish their bank account details to this office by filing authentic copy of passbook/ Bank documents.
06. Office of Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Thane, on receipt of amount, shall, forthwith, transfer it in bank account of the petitioners.
07. Court fee be refunded to the petitioners, as per rules.
08. Award be drawn up accordingly.
