

**Com O.S. 149/2025**

The matter is taken before Lok-Adalath.

Both the parties and their counsel present and filed a compromise petition U/o. XXIII Rule 3 of CPC.

Substance of the compromise petition is read over and explained both the parties.

Both the parties admitted the settlement between them in terms of the compromise petition and they executing the compromise petition.

Plaintiff acknowledged receipt of Rs. 1,00,000/- from the defendants in terms of the compromise petition.

We are satisfied that both the parties have voluntarily entered into the compromise and same has to accepted at the better interest of both the parties.

Accordingly, compromise petition filed by both parties U/o. XXIII Rule 3 of CPC is accepted.
